- Site development – January 6, 2011

- Waterproofing, water intrusion prevention and mold prevention – May 5, 2011
- Interior finishes – July 7, 2011
- Doors and windows – August 4, 2011
- Elevators – September 1, 2011
- Mechanical and plumbing systems – October 6, 2011
- Electrical systems – November 3, 2011

Project managers, superintendents, and foremen – anyone involved with the management of construction projects will benefit from this program.

The ABC Hardhat Roundtable will meet monthly on the first Thursday from 4:30 to 6:00 pm at the ABC office in Knoxville except for June and December. The first session will be January 6, 2011.

There will be no cost to ABC members for the program.
